



After GCSEs you are able to access three-years of full-time study free of charge, and you can do an apprenticeship at any age (if you are 19+ your employer will have to contribute to apprenticeship fees).

If you know the career route you want to follow, why wait? You can start your career now with an apprenticeship programme, where you can:

- Earn a real salary (usually from £100 per week)
- Learn skills in the workplace
- Train with a workplace mentor and our experienced team of college tutors

We have a recruitment team to help you get started. Our advisors will help you with applications, CV writing and provide you with interview guidance to help you stand out from the crowd.

Throughout your apprenticeship you will have the support of your college tutor to ensure your learning is on track and an apprenticeship advisor who will visit you at work and make sure you are happy and thriving in the workplace.

Apprenticeships can also take you higher, with a range of new Higher Apprenticeships now available, you may be able to continue your apprenticeship on to degree-level. Many apprenticeship programmes also offer UCAS tariff points giving you the chance to go on to university if you want to later in life. Apprenticeships can also lead on to further professional qualifications that could advance your career.

All of our courses have a work experience element and this is where you will gain insight into possible future careers and immerse yourself in real work; on your CV this will show future employers you are work ready. Some programmes in hair and beauty, hospitality, and engineering will also offer 350 hours of industry placement.

### WORK COMPETENCIES

We prepare you for the workplace by helping you develop work ready skills which include punctuality, reliability, meeting deadlines, communication, resilience, problem solving, innovation, financial acumen, planning, prioritising and much more.

### SPECIALIST KNOWLEDGE

We have strong partnerships with employers who help shape the curriculum, to make sure your training is relevant, giving you an edge when you start your chosen career.

## INDUSTRY PLACEMENT AND WORK EXPERIENCE PLACEMENT

It is a requirement for all 16-18 funded Study Programme learners, as part of your course, to undertake a Work Experience Placement with a local employer, who works in the same sector as the area in which you will be studying, this would be for a minimum duration of one week, with some programmes requiring more weeks than others.

Level 3 Study Programme learners are expected to complete an Industry Placement, which is a minimum of 315 hours (approx. 45 days) and involves actively contributing to the workplace whilst working on targets which you have set yourself. These targets may be hard skills i.e. knowledge and skills related to the industry, as well as soft skills i.e. behaviours, values and employability.

The Industry Placement and Work Experience Placement that you undertake will depend on your course and circumstances. This will be discussed in more detail at your interview.

Work Experience and Industry Placements offer an exciting opportunity to enhance your skills and knowledge, allow you to understand first-hand the sector in which you would like to work and get you not only work ready, but potentially open up employment opportunities for you on completion of your course.

Our dedicated Skills to Business team will support you in finding placements that are suitable and will be available at college interview events to arrange this, however you may find it useful to start researching now, where you might like your placement to take place. When the course begins, we will liaise with the learner and employer around the dates of the placement and will complete the necessary paperwork, this will ensure that the placement is planned properly and that it is beneficial and safe for all parties concerned.

The Cornwall College Group will support you with the setting of targets and will ensure all employers are fully vetted in order to meet the high standards that we set.

# COURSE LEVELS AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

It is important to choose the correct level of course after your GCSEs, whether you intend to go on to university, an apprenticeship or into employment. Making the right choice will depend on meeting the entry requirements, how you like to study and what you would like to do on completion of your studies.

Please use the table below as a general guide to our entry requirements. All courses require a determination to achieve in your chosen subject area. Acceptance on a course will also depend on a successful interview.

### Please note

- \*For any applicants considering undertaking an apprenticeship, you will need an employer willing to take you on as an apprentice, which is a process that we can support you in. With regards to entry requirements, please note that prior to starting an apprenticeship you will need to complete an initial assessment in English and maths, so that we can establish the level you are currently working at. We will then run through a Skills Scan with you, in order to determine your current level of knowledge and skills in your chosen area of study. Both of these elements will then be used to determine the level of apprenticeship which is most suitable for you to start at, irrespective of grades awarded in previous qualifications.
- Some specialist courses may have extra entry requirements, please see website for details.
- If you do not achieve your expected grades please do not panic. Contact us and we will help you find an alternative course, normally in the same subject area of interest.

# GCSE GRADES

## GCSE GRADES UPDATE

In 2017 the grading system for GCSE English and maths changed significantly. Rather than being graded A\* to G, a numerical system is now used. The grades now run from 1 to 9, with 9 being the highest. A grade 4 is now a 'standard pass', equivalent to a grade C, with a grade 5 being a 'strong pass'.

### GCSE ENGLISH AND MATHS

According to the Department for Education, gaining a grade 4 or higher in English and maths could potentially add £2,000 to your salary every year. If you have not yet gained a grade 4 in GCSE English and maths then you will carry on studying these subjects as part of your Study Programme at college. Our English and maths teams are committed to helping you succeed, and we offer a different and more personalised experience than school.

Our GCSE courses run from September until June, giving you the chance to gain your qualification in just one academic year.

Not quite ready for GCSE yet? Don't worry, we have a range of 'stepping stone' qualifications in English and maths meaning that you can improve your skills at your own pace. If you have already gained your GCSE English and maths at grade 4, we will continue to embed English and maths into your specialist course, as these skills are essential for your future employment.

When you join us, we will assess your current levels of English and maths, and use your existing qualifications to make sure that you are on the right course for you.

We also have a range of mannequins, from life-size Labradors to not so life-size ponies and with working farms and equestrian centres you will also have access to animals seen in large animal practices. Our Rosewarne facilities are the only ones of their kind in the county.



Supporting this you will also have the chance to build core knowledge of vehicle construction, materials and methods as well as usual workshop health and safety best practice.

70% of your time will be spent in the workshop carrying out practical work, which could be welding repairs, panel repairs or

respraying vehicles. You will also learn how to take panels off and refit them, how to carry out panel beating and filler repairs and we also have a spray booth where you will learn how to spray primers, etch primers and high build primers. Our spray booth is designed for water-based paints using industry standard technology.

Many of our former students are working in industry in Cornwall, the UK or abroad, with some running their own body shops.

**Progression:** Employment in the industry.

### GAMES DESIGN & ANIMATION DIPLOMA LEVEL 3

This two-year course is practically focused and coursework based and you will learn the skills needed to move onto university or your first steps into the ever expanding UK games industry. We focus on the development of games and game art and assets, so you don't need to be a coding master to succeed.

In the first year of the course you will look at the analysis and design of games, create 2D and 3D levels, undertake market research of your own game ideas and prepare those ideas for development, learn employability skills and manage teams to create products, investigate web design and analyse and create sound effects for games. You will even create a fully realised board game, use 3D printing techniques and a full production process to launch the product in a live premiere event – and all in just ten days.

In year two you will create social action games, research and produce academic essays, apply for university and get your career goals set up alongside making your own 3D animated characters.

Both years will see you create your own final projects for end of year assessment.



For those students who don't quite meet the entry requirements we also run a one-year Media & Animation Diploma Level 2 designed to feed directly into the games course the following year.

## Independence Pathway

Preparing for adulthood with a focus on independence; confidence; resilience; physical and sensory development, and skills to enhance quality of life.

### PERSONAL PROGRESS TOWARDS INDEPENDENCE STAGE 1

**Where:** Camborne

This course helps to develop your independence. This is achieved through knowledge and skills that will support your transition to adulthood, with a clear focus on developing your personal progress in this area. On this pathway you will work towards individual personal targets linked to different areas of independence, which may include: Learning to travel by bus or train; independent living at home, e.g. basic home cooking skills or keeping the home clean and tidy; independent living in the community, which may include learning to go shopping or going to a restaurant; personal development, such as learning to keep safe and the importance of staying healthy. We will work with you, your parents and carers in designing your programme of study, setting your targets and assessing progress inside and outside of college.

**Progression:** Once you have completed this pathway you may wish to progress on to other pathways within Foundation Learning such as Skills or Works. If you leave college, you will leave with skills that will enable you to be more independent at home or in the community.

## Independence Pathway

### PERSONAL PROGRESS TOWARDS INDEPENDENCE STAGE 2

**Where:** Camborne and St Austell

Within this pathway you will focus on developing your independence and you could also develop your vocational skills. We will support you in developing your skills in using English and maths too. Aside from the academic skills, we will work with you to develop a range of social and interaction skills to help prepare you for your next steps. ### VOCATIONAL STUDIES STAGE 1

**Where:** Bicton College, Camborne, Duchy College Stoke Climsland and St Austell

This course is ideal if you are unsure of the subject you wish to pursue as a career. You will experience a range of vocational options to help you make that choice. The options on offer are specific to the campus you choose to study at. During the course you will study vocational and life skills around the areas of work that you have chosen to study. You will also build your teamwork skills, self-confidence and develop your English and maths.

**Progression:** Pathway 2 Employment (P2E) Stage 1.

## Vocational Pathway

### VOCATIONAL STUDIES STAGE 2

**Where:** Camborne

During these steps to becoming work ready you will set personal targets to ensure you reach the goals you need to enter the next stage in your career. You will get the opportunity to visit local employers and also follow a career plan to match your skills and interests with different jobs and careers and, where relevant, work with the P2E co-ordinator to find the right work placement for your supported internship at stage 2. Work experience opportunities will range from placements including our on-site shop and coffee shop, to placements within other college departments.

**Progression:** Pathway 2 Employment Stage 2 (Supported Internship).

## Works Pathway

### WORK-RELATED STUDIES

**Where:** Camborne

You will learn the skills, knowledge and behaviours to prepare you for the world of work. During these steps to becoming work ready you will set personal targets to ensure you reach the goals you need to enter the next stage in your career. You will get the opportunity to visit local employers and also follow a career plan to match your skills and interests with different jobs and careers and work with the P2E co-ordinator to find the right work placement for your supported internship at stage 2, if you chose this progression pathway.




