



Assessing Vocational Achievement City & Guilds Certificate

□ Ideal if

you are practitioners who need to be qualified to use all methods of assessment - i.e. those who will be carrying out the role of an assessor in a work environment and vocationally related situation (i.e. classroom/workshop/simulated environments).

□ You'll need

to be working with/attached to an Approved Assessment Centre that is offering the QCF/NVQ Award you are planning to assess and have two real learners to assess in a real work environment and assess in a simulated environment i.e. in a workshop or classroom.

□ You'll learn

the background knowledge and understanding aspects of the Award and the assessor role you will be required to carry out. You will continue to work with the Course Tutor through group/one-to-one support at subsequent sessions.

□ Expect

to work closely with at least two learners, through components of their qualification. You will meet with your Course Tutor/Assessor regularly and build a portfolio of evidence. You will also be required to work/liaise with other assessors and internal quality assurance staff at your Assessment Centre.
