This apprenticeship is designed for people who want to train on the job and gain a nationally recognised qualification in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools.

You must enjoy working with children and young adults, be confident in the classroom environment and have sufficient language, literacy and numeracy skills.

During this apprenticeship, you will attend classes at one of our campuses, one day per week, for 12 months.

The main areas of teaching in class include promoting positive behaviour, supporting learning assessment and activities, understanding development and safeguarding of children and young people.

You will put together a portfolio of evidence to show that you are competent at the tasks you do every day, while receiving support from experienced Cornwall College tutors.

Upon successful completion, you will be awarded the following qualification:

- Level 2 in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools

You enjoy working with children in education and would like to start your career in a school setting supporting the class teacher.

□ You'll need

Functional Skills Level 2 in English and mathematics, or relevant experience, plus an offer of an apprenticeship within a primary school setting. You will also need to be able to generate evidence of competence in the workplace.

Through a range of interesting topics including child development, health and safety, safeguarding, personal development, communication, equality and diversity and schools as organisations.
