Facilitated by a team of professionals with established research in equine welfare, health, biomechanics, psychology, horse/human interactions and also the management and development of equine enterprises. This array of knowledge combined with close working links with industry develops graduates capable of undertaking a useful role in the equine industry supporting and managing equine enterprises. The programme works closely with industry and develops skills to be applied in a wide range of areas including managing horse welfare in different contexts, business development, and marketing, managing different types of equine businesses and human resource management. Team work and managing a team is emphasised throughout and learners will be learning by doing where applicable, work based learning is compulsory throughout the programme. This will require learners to engage a range of skills needed in reality; physical resource management, knowledge of planning for the health of equines, equine handling skills, knowledge of the legal requirements for managing equine facilities, financial implications within equine resource management and the ability to communicate and negotiate with others will support the ever changing needs of the equine industry.
