



RHS Advanced Certificate in Practical Horticulture Level 3

A practical-based qualification to improve the horticultural skills needed for career development to supervisory or management roles, or to further develop your interest. This course is ideal if you are self employed within horticulture and would like a formal qualification.

This course is also offered at Rosemoor in North Devon.

□ Ideal if

you have a keen interest in gardening and wish to develop your skills to a higher level with supporting underpinning knowledge.

□ You'll need

to have completed the RHS level 2 practical certificate, have an equivalent qualification or have relevant experience.

□ You'll learn

- Propagation (seed sowing and a range of cutting types)
- Soil preparation and planting
- Pruning, soil testing and grafting.

You are also required to identify a wide range of plants and seeds by their botanical names, plus pests and diseases by their common names.

□ Expect

To achieve this level 3 practical certificate you will need to complete all of the practical tests and identification tests and underpinning knowledge assessment proformas in the form of short reports and risk assessments. This will involve some research and an element of homework.
