This course is delivered at Richmond House, Resource Centre, Penzance.

On this course, you will explore a variety of clay-modelling and hand-building techniques to create items such as bowls, vases, mugs, and plates. You'll also have the opportunity to design animated figures and learn a range of decorative ceramic processes to produce imaginative and colourful pottery. Additionally, the course will introduce you to sculptural and animated forms inspired by ceramic artists throughout history.

Guided by an experienced tutor, you'll receive support tailored to help you achieve your creative goals while developing your own unique style. You'll also be encouraged to think about design, form, and function as you shape your ideas.

The Road to Wellbeing courses are relaxed and informal, designed to support your mental health and wellbeing. By building self-confidence and self-esteem, these classes offer a positive and welcoming environment. They're also a great way to meet new people and make friends. We offer courses suited to all skill levels and abilities.

Duration - 8-12 weeks – half a day per week either morning or afternoon.

You will be expected to attend each week.

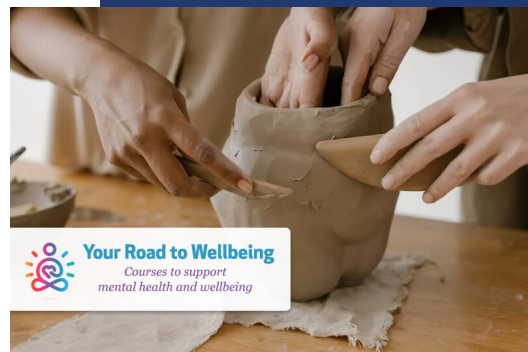

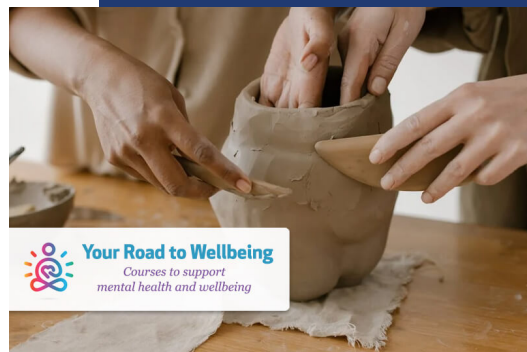
