

# Understanding The Safe Handling Of Medication In Health And Social Care Certificate Level 2

Adult

This qualification aims to help learners develop a general understanding of different types of medication and their use and knowledge of the procedures for obtaining, storing, administering and disposing of medication.

Learners will also develop an understanding of legislation and the audit process related to medication and issues of responsibility and accountability.

Aged 19+ at the beginning of the academic year and will need to have the right to study in the UK and been a resident for a minimum of 3 years.

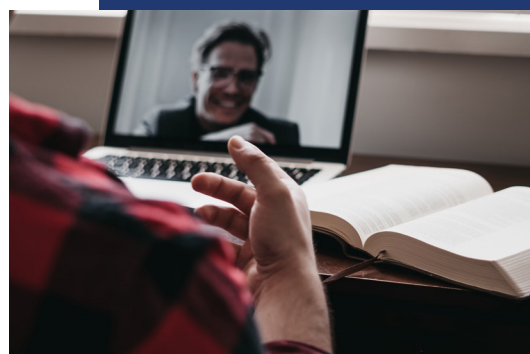

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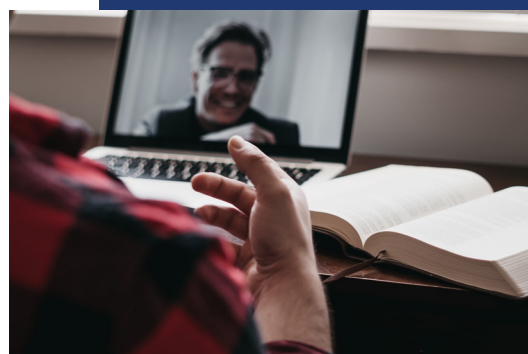
