ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entry requirements for external applicants and school leavers

- Two or more GCSEs at Grade 2 or above, or successful completion of an Entry Level qualification.
- Learners with relevant industry experience but no GCSEs at Grade 2 may be considered based on interview. For some courses this may include GCSE English or maths grade 2 or equivalent.



Entry requirements for existing learners with the Cornwall College Group

- Successful completion of previous course and, where relevant, meet the English and/or maths requirements of the Level 1 course.
