

What to do if...	Action Needed	Return to college when...
<b>PLEASE NOTE: For all references to 'Contact College' or 'Ring College' below please do this by following the normal Absence Reporting process you are familiar with.</b>		
...my daughter/son has Covid-19 symptoms.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do not come to college</li> <li>Contact college to inform us</li> <li>Self-isolate the whole household</li> <li>Get a test</li> <li>Inform the college immediately about the test result</li> </ul>	...the test comes back negative or a period of 10 days has passed since the symptoms started, and the daughter/son feels well
...my daughter/son tests positive for Covid-19.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do not come to college</li> <li>Contact college to inform us</li> <li>Agree an earliest date for possible return (minimum of 10 days)</li> <li>Self-isolate the whole household</li> </ul>	...10 days have passed since symptoms began, even if they still have a cough or loss of taste/smell. <i>(These symptoms can last for several weeks.)</i> <b>AND</b> the daughter/son feels well.
...my daughter/son tests negative.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Contact college to inform us</li> <li>Discuss when your daughter/son can come back (same day/next day)</li> </ul>	...the test comes back negative.
...my daughter/son is ill with symptoms not linked to Covid-19.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do not come to college</li> <li>Contact college to inform us</li> <li>Ring on each day of illness</li> </ul>	...after 48 hours following the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea (as per attendance policy).
...someone in my household has Covid-19 symptoms.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do not come to college</li> <li>Contact college to inform us</li> <li>Self-isolate the whole household</li> <li>Symptomatic household member to get a test</li> <li>Inform college immediately about test result</li> </ul>	...the test comes back negative.
...someone in my household tests positive for Covid-19.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do not come to college.</li> <li>Contact college to inform us.</li> <li>Agree an earliest date for possible return (minimum of 14 days).</li> <li>Self-isolate the whole household.</li> </ul>	... daughter/son has completed 14 days of isolation.
...NHS test and trace has identified my daughter/son as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed Covid-19.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do not come to college</li> <li>Contact college to inform us</li> <li>Agree an earliest date for possible return (minimum of 14 days)</li> </ul>	...the daughter/son has completed 14 days of isolation.
...NHS test and trace has identified a household member (other than my daughter/son) as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed Covid-19.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The household member must self-isolate for 14 days</li> <li>Daughter/son can continue to attend college</li> </ul>	...daughter/son can continue to attend college.
... a sibling attending another college/school has been sent home to self-isolate due to there being a positive case in their college/school.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sibling at other college must self-isolate for 14 days</li> </ul>	...daughter/son can continue to attend college.
... my daughter/son has travelled abroad from a country or territory that is NOT on the exempt list of countries.	<p><b>If returning from a destination where quarantine is needed*:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Minimum of 14 days self-isolation for all those who travelled</li> <li>Contact college to inform us you are back in the country and we will agree an earliest date for possible</li> </ul>	...the quarantine period of 14 days has been completed.

	<p>return to college</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Self-isolate the whole household</li> </ul> <p><b>*<a href="#">Foreign, Commonwealth &amp; Development Office (FCDO)</a></b> – for up to date travel information</p>	
... my daughter/son has travelled abroad from a country or territory that IS on the exempt list of countries.	<p><b>If returning from a destination where quarantine is NOT needed:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Check the current <a href="#">Exempt countries and territories list</a> to confirm the country you have travelled from or through is on the exempt list.</li> <li>Ring college to inform us you have returned to the UK and agree a return date to college.</li> </ul>	... you have informed the college of your return to the UK ( <i>the office will ask you a few questions about your travel</i> ).
...I have travelled from a country that requires us to quarantine (but my daughter/son didn't travel).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>As long as you do not have / have not had symptoms in the last 14 days, your daughter/son can continue to attend college</li> <li>The person who has travelled <b>MUST NOT</b> leave the house, including to do pick-ups and drop offs (<i>please contact college if you need support getting your daughter/son to college</i>)</li> </ul>	...daughter/son can continue to attend college.
...we have received medical advice that my daughter/son must resume shielding.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Do not come to college</b></li> <li><b>Contact college to inform us</b></li> <li>Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again</li> </ul>	...college inform you that restrictions have been lifted and your daughter/son can return to college again. ...you receive medical advice that your daughter/son may return to college.
...my daughter/son's bubble is closed due to a Covid-19 outbreak in college.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Daughter/son must not come to college</b></li> <li>Support your daughter/son at home with remote education provided by the college.</li> <li>Your daughter/son will need to self-isolate for 14 days</li> <li><b>Other siblings may continue to attend college</b></li> </ul>	...college inform you that the bubble will be reopened.
... I am unable to get a test for someone in the household who has symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If you are not able to get a test in the first 5 days of having symptoms, your daughter/son and anyone they live with must stay at home and self-isolate for 14 days. Anyone in your support bubble must also stay at home.</li> </ul>	...daughter/son has completed 14 days of isolation.
