

FINANCE

There's lots to think about when becoming a student, and sorting your budget should be a top priority.

Knowing what you have to spend each week will help ensure you don't get into unmanageable debt and means you're likely to have a better time, as you won't be worrying about money.


Your student loan is paid into your bank account in three instalments (usually at the start of each term), the big temptation will be to burn through it, especially in freshers' week, but don't, that money has to last, so spend it wisely.

Look at how much cash you'll have coming in.

Realistically work out how much money you'll have going out.

Then subtract your outgoings from your income and divide it by the number of weeks there are during a term.

Once you've done this, you'll have an idea of how much you'll have to live off week-by-week.





Once your application has been received you will receive an invitation to attend an interview with the programme team. If your interview is successful you will be made an offer.

If your offer is unconditional and you accept there is nothing further for you to do until it's time to enrol.

If your offer is conditional and you accept there is nothing further for you to do until we have received your end of year results (usually August).
