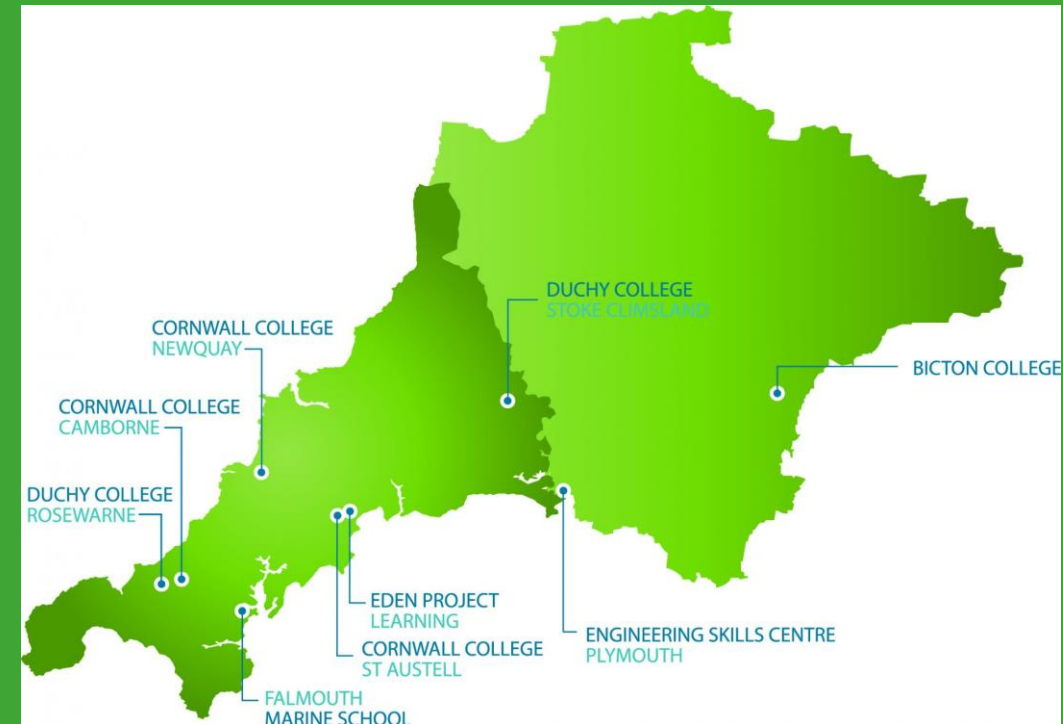


Elective Home Education



A new offer for Elective Home Educated Year 11 learners

- From September 2023 we will be offering a Course Infill offer to students registered with Cornwall or Devon County Council as Elective Home educated
- This will be available at:
 - Cornwall College St Austell
 - Cornwall College Camborne
 - Duchy College Stoke Climsland
 - Duchy College Rosewarne
 - Bicton College
 - Falmouth Marine School

How will it work?

- EHE Learners will choose a single subject to study from one of our specialisms
- They will join an existing Post 16 group
- EHE learners will be fully integrated into their chosen group and have access to the full delivery of that course
- They will also be able to use college facilities such as the Learning Centre, social spaces, college food outlets and the gym (different campuses have different facilities)
- They will undertake around 2 days a week, timetable dependent
- They will have time in the rest of the week to pursue other EHE subjects or activities

What courses are on offer?

- Year long courses only
- The courses depend on the site
 - The best place to start is our website cornwall.ac.uk looking at the 16-18 options
- Apprenticeships are not available pre 16, nor are a few select qualifications due to exam board restrictions, for example Motor Vehicle.
- About our courses:
 - Career College – everything aligned to an industry or profession
 - Level 1, Level 2 – the level will be decided based on prior attainment, what's available in the subject area and interview
 - Adult infill – we allow adult infill into our 16-18 courses



How do we apply?

- The best way is by emailing TCCGPre16@cornwall.ac.uk
 - If you apply directly through the college website make sure you make it clear in the notes that the prospective learner is EHE
- We'll do an initial check with the local authority to ensure you're EHE registered
- Then you'll be invited to an interview with the relevant Head of Campus and Assistant Principal
- Following that the Curriculum Team and the Student Experience Manager will interview you and an offer of a course will be made at that stage

More information

- At interview we will have more information about the practicalities of coming to college
- Transport is not being provided
- This is only available for learners who are 15/16 and would normally be in Year 11 if at school
- It is only available for learners who are not on school roll anywhere
- The onus is on the parent to arrange the remainder of the educational experience outside of the college hours
- Learners can start during September and October of each Academic year
- We're not delivering English or Maths to Pre 16 learners

Why not English and Maths?

- We're not able to offer GCSE English or Maths (or Functional Skills) because our delivery model is based on school resit learners
- Providing E&M would make us the sole provider of a learners education which would increase the timetable they were required to study at college and mean we treated them as a full time learner, we don't believe this appropriate for EHE learners as their wider education is so rich and diverse
- We do offer 25 private places in GCSE English and Maths exams at our Camborne Campus which can be applied for
- The funding agency will not allow students to be registered at multiple institutions

Private Candidate Arrangements

We offer access to AQA GCSE (9-1) in English Language (60142923) and AQA GCSE (9-1) in Mathematics (60146084) examinations in the summer series for EHE candidates in year 9 above at Cornwall College Camborne

Maximum of 25 places for English and 25 places for Maths

Places will be available in a sperate dedicated space.

Provision for candidates requiring access arrangements, including study needs assessments, will **not** be offered due to capacity and resource constraints (such as rooms and invigilators)

Charge a fee per qualification of £190.

This is comprised of a registration fee of £90 and an administrative fee of £100. Payment will be taken before registrations are completed;
